A Philip Randolph: And thus, we have come now to this period, when the work of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People is being supplemented by new civil rights organizations: Dr. Martin Luther King and his Southern Christian Leadership Conference, the Nonviolent Coordinating Committee of Students in the South, and the Congress of Racial Equality, and the National Urban League. These organizations are carrying the [bough] in the interest of the creation of first class citizenship to peoples of color in the country at this time.
